Pistol Camp August 7-9, 2015 Hosted by the Illinois Rifle Association

The National Rifle Association and The Scholastic Pistol Program are proud to announce the first annual Scholastic Pistol Program Pistol Camp. The camp will take place August 7th through the 9th, 2015 at the Illinois State Rifle Association Range at Bonfield located in Kankakee, Illinois. **Registration deadline is July 31.**

The unique camp, sponsored by the NRA, will be limited to 32 athletes and will feature both range and classroom training aimed to take an athlete to the next level.

We will be using .22 LR for the camp (ammo is included in the cost of the camp) and pistols will be available for those that do not have a suitable gun. If an athlete prefers to use their 9mm pistol they will be required to furnish their own ammo (650 rds).

Please complete the **Registration Form and Health History Form** and return it to Tammy Mowry.

Registration Fee for the Pistol Camp is: Normally the registration fee for a special camp like this would be \$300 per camper. But due to a special grant by the NRA Foundation, the cost per camper will only be \$150!

In addition there will be a Level 1 Pistol Coaches certification being offered at the same time.

The Coach certification is offered to the adults and is a separate program, not part of the curriculum for the athletes **but** anyone over 15 could attend the Coach class (15-17 = Junior Pistol Trainer, 18 and up = Coach).

The coach school is the heart of the coach education program. The instructors use up-to-date materials and PowerPoint presentations to present the discipline-specific coach course.

The registration fee includes a copy of the discipline-specific coach student study guide and other materials to help you with the details of coaching. Participants complete an open-book test as homework during the first evening of the course.

SPP/NRA/USA Shooting Level 1 Pistol Coaches School

August 7-9, 2015

Pre-registration is required

The coach school is the heart of the coach education program. The instructors use up-to-date materials and PowerPoint presentations to present the discipline-specific coach course.

The registration fee includes a copy of the discipline-specific coach student study guide and other materials to help you with the details of coaching. Participants complete an open-book test as homework during the first evening of the course. The test is graded in class, reviewed for understanding, and then submitted to the NRA National Coach Trainer by the school instructor for credential processing. Upon successful completion of the coach school you will be a Coach (Level 1) (or Youth Trainer if under 18 years old) in that discipline. A Coach Credential Card is sent to the new coach.

What is taught in the school?

The coach school is two days of sports-specific lessons and practical coaching exercises designed to teach the coach candidate the basics of coaching. The following general subjects are taught:

- Introduction to the Coaching Program
- Safety and Risk Management
- Competition Events
- Rulebook Use
- Equipment and Facilities
- Fundamentals of Shooting
- Coaching Ethics
- Coaching Methodology
- Sports Psychology
- Training Planning
- Running Quality Programs
- How to Conduct Tournament





SPP/NRA/USA Shooting Level 1 Pistol Coaches School August 7-9, 2015

The Level 1 pistol coach's course through the National Rifle Association, USA Shooting, and the Scholastic Pistol Program covers all required coaching fundamentals for pistol coaches in the Scholastic Shooting Sports Foundation's Scholastic Pistol Program (SPP) in addition to other disciplines of pistol competition. The training is provided by the SPP/NRA/USAS National Coach Development Staff (NCDS). The course duration is 2 days with class running from 8:00 a.m. to 5:00 p.m. each day. Candidates should bring eye and ear protection and note-taking materials with them.

The cost of the course is \$190 which includes all printed materials, 3 year coaching credentials with the NRA, a binder for your materials, and lunch/refreshments each day. **Students who are current SPP coaches will be charged \$160. For students who become an SPP Coach within three months of the course will have their \$30 coach's fee waived.**
