The purpose of this MOU is to facilitate mutual support for both parties of this MOU by outlining a list of commitments for each.

Commitments

- Sending a chapter representative to a team meeting to inform athletes and parents about our PF/QF mission, our role in wildlife conservation and promote annual fundraising efforts.
- Providing a leadership opportunity to at least one team member to serve on the chapter committee as a team liaison.
- Financially supporting the shooting team by providing direct financial support or a fundraising mechanism to the team.
- Providing the team access to PF/QF programs (youth events, banquets, ammo grants, etc).
- Providing a minimum of 20 PF/QF youth memberships to the team.
- The ______ shooting team commits to:
 - Providing a PF/QF chapter representative an opportunity to attend a team meeting with parents to talk about the PF/QF mission and share information about fundraising efforts.
 - Providing a team captain or other team member to serve as the team liaison on the chapter committee.
 - Taking an active role in fundraising efforts that help support the team.
 - Supporting the PF/QF chapter by providing a minimum of five team members to assist with at least one chapter sponsored youth event and the annual fundraising banquet.

MOU TERMS

This is an "at-will" MOU and may be modified by mutual consent of authorized representatives from both parties. The MOU becomes effective upon signature by both parties and remains in effect for one year from date of signatures.
