





Anyone wishing to practice Skeet or Trap on days that are not available at the Cardinal Center, can do so at the Black Wing Shooting facility, our official practice range. Information available at registration and sign up!

Adult/Coach supervision required to purchase practice rounds and while shooting.
**Drivers License is required to purchase practice keys. License will be held on file until practice key is returned.

Registration:

Head Coaches must check in at the Central Events Building, verify their team entry and squadding information, and pick up their Shoot Packets in person. All coaches will be required to sign off on their team's squadding, verifying that all squads and divisions are correct! Squads with mixed division athletes will be placed in the Open division. However, they must be complete (full) squads. Team and athlete event registration fees may be refunded through July 10. After July 10, there will be no refunds for pre-registered athletes.

Divisions and Categories:

Rookie - 5th Grade and Under

Intermediate Division / Entry – 6th to 8th Grade (First Year Competing as Intermediate)

Intermediate Division / Advanced - 7th and 8th Grade

Senior Division / Junior Varsity — 9th to 12th Grade (First Year Competing in Senior Division)

Senior Division / Varsity – 9th to 12th Grade

Open Division – Includes any combination of division athletes listed above. Open division does NOT include college-aged athletes.

Collegiate - New

Athletes must have participated in an accredited SCTP College Program in 2017-2018. College Division will include ALL Collegiate and College Open squads this year.

SCTP will host an SCTP College Championship tournament, October 26 – 28, 2018 at the Cardinal Center in Marengo, OH. This is open to all SCTP-registered college teams and athletes. Four divisions (to include two-year colleges) eligible for trophies, medals, and lots of fun!

Matt will be at the Action Pistol Berms on Wednesday at 10:00am and Thursday at 11:00am. Matt is a USPSA Grand Master, CZ-USA shooting team member, shooting a SP-01 Shadow. He is a Limited and Open ProAm Champion, won 7th at the 2014 USPSA Nationals, is a 6-time Missouri State Champion and has earned over 25 production division state titles.

Max Michel - SIG SAUER Team Captain

Max is the IPSC World Champions with 6 International team gold medals, a world-renowned firearms trainer and runs the Max Michel Training Academy. Max is the current Guinness World Book of Records speed shooting record holder. A former member of the Army Marksmanship Unit, Max spent ten years in the US Army. Max is the only person in history to win all of the USPSA area championships in the same season.

Ashley Rheuark - GLOCK

Ashley was first introduced to shooting at age 10 while out hunting with her dad. After discovering her natural skill with a rifle, Ashley attended a basic pistol class, sparking her passion for the sport of competitive shooting. Her dad purchased her first pistol, a GLOCK 19, and Ashley fell in love instantly. In 2017, she took home the gold medal at the IPSC Rifle World Shoot in the Open Division, Lady Category. As a Pro Shooter for Team SIG, Lena focuses mainly on 3-Gun and pistol caliber carbine competitions where she dominates the leader boards.



ADDITIONAL GUIDELINES FOR SCTP & SASP:

- 1. Current ATA, NSCA, NSSA, USA Shooting and SASP rules, as well as rules in this program and any match or National Director's bulletins posted on this range, govern this match.
- 2. All participating athletes and coaches must be registered and fully paid with the SSSF before competing. Event registrations are accepted on a first-come, first-served basis. For SCTP and SASP, all reservations will be done electronically through the team login at www.sssfonline.org.
- 3. All ammunition and practice rounds are the responsibility of the participant.
- 4. Alcohol/illegal or individually non-prescribed drugs and firearms do not mix. Alcohol and other illegal substances are strictly forbidden by the SSSF during this event. Further, any person who is found to be in possession of, or under the influence of, alcohol or drugs while using, cleaning, maintaining, inspecting, or otherwise handling their shotgun or any other firearm at any time will be immediately disqualified from the entire event and asked to leave without refund.
- **5.** Safe gun handling and appropriate shooting attire are required. Flip-flops and open-toed shoes are prohibited. No tank tops, mid-drift tops or shorts above mid-thigh are allowed.


Reprimands will be issued based on violation and could ultimately mean disqualification from the tournament.

- **6.** Hat shooting is strictly prohibited during competition. Once all competition has been completed, hat shooting may occur 1) ONLY after receiving permission from the tournament director or staff member and 2) under the supervision of a state advisor or coach. Any competitor who participates in hat shooting outside of both of these conditions will be immediately disqualified and asked to leave the competition without refund.
- **7.** All shooters must sign the score sheet (next to the score total) before leaving the range.
- **8.** Use of any tobacco product by anyone under the age of 18 is against Ohio State Law, and any use of tobacco product by an SCTP/SASP participant under the age of 18 is against SSSF guidelines. Participating in the use of tobacco products can be grounds for disqualification from the tournament.
- **9.** Any athlete or adult disqualified from the tournament will not receive a refund of any tournament fees, game fees, practice fees or any other funds paid to SSSF or it agents.
- 10. 1st-5th place ties in the Individual Skeet & Trap events will be broken by long run back and then long run front. Sporting Clays ties will be broken by three predesignated tie-breaker stations. SASP ties will be broken per rule book. If a tie occurs for final ranking, the In & Out stage score will be used as the tie-breaker. If that does not break the tie, the fastest single run of that stage will be used as the tie-breaker. If still needed, the second and third run will be used as the tie breaker.
