

2020 SCTP College Virtual Competition

September 7 – October 11

Welcome to your 2020 SCTP College Virtual Competition!

Please find below some rules and guidelines to follow while competing in this year's event. The College Virtual competition is open to all registered and current members of the SCTP, coaches must register and pay for all athletes wishing to participate in this event through the SHOT system PRIOR to the event starting. The squad slots are for scores only, please reference your teams squad number for any correspondence before or during the event.

Rules & Fodder:

- 1.) All participating athletes must be currently registered and paid with the SCTP National organization.
- 2.) All scores MUST be turned in by midnight of the Sunday of each week, NO EXCEPTIONS! Information on score submittal will be available for coaches.
- 3.) Coaches must retain ALL score sheets for ALL athletes for at least 10 days following the event. SCTP staff may verify the top 5 finishing athletes and/or teams scores. Score sheets should be verified and initialed by the scorer and teams designated head coach before being submitted.
- 4.) Coaches, the integrity of this event is solely up to you. Teaching our students honesty and life lessons is what this is all about, we hope that you can use this event as a stepping stone for your athletes shooting careers!
- 5.) Team scoring will be utilized for this event in the following divisions; **Division 1** (20 or more athlete teams), **Division 2** (11-19 athlete teams), **Division 3** (10 or less and new college teams), **Division 4** (All 2-year college teams). Team awards as well as individual awards will be presented to the top 3 teams as well as Male and Female athletes in each discipline and division! For Team awards, the teams top 5 scores will be counted for that teams score.
- 6.) These events are non-registered targets. Teams may, however, shoot registered targets at an event that may be going on at the same time and submit those scores for this competition. Please contact your Director of Development if you have any questions in that regard.

Guidelines and Ideas:

- 1.) Coaches, a designated score sheet should be provided for athletes to sign up and shoot the event. Many teams/clubs use a different color score pad or a score sheet that states "Competition Round" on it.
- 2.) This is a competition!! Please coaches, NO COACHING while athletes are on the line shooting!
- 3.) With "Team Scoring" in place, coaches can squad their athletes as they see fit. Many athletes like to shoot with their buddies, that is fine! This should be a fun event with fun memories being made with an enjoyable experience!
- 4.) To create that "Competition" experience, we recommend when possible to shoot these events with another local team or 2! Make this a great experience and have fun!
- 5.) The SCTP reserves the right to audit and verify any and all scores. Please make sure that all score sheets are initialed by the score keeper and the teams designated head coach. Falsifying, submitting incorrect scores and/or cheating will be grounds for disqualification of those athletes and team! Coaches do the right thing and teach these athletes the right way, we are counting on you!
- 6.) We recommend possibly getting together with another team (or more) at a location that can accommodate all your athletes. This will also give that competition feel!!
