- One camping unit with family of 2 adults, 2 children per campsite.
- Check-in time 1:00 PM, Check-out time 11:00 AM.
- Trash to be placed in provided dumpsters upon departure.
- Please respect your neighbor; quiet hours are 11:00 PM to 8:00 AM.
- Parents are responsible for their children in all areas of the campground; please do not leave them unattended in pool, shower house, or play ground.
- Golf carts & Side by Sides to be driven on established roads. No person may operate any motorized vehicle on park property without a valid driver's license, proof of insurance and minimum liability coverage. There is a \$20 yearly registration fee for golf carts and \$50 for Side by Sides.
- Fishing pond is catch & release.

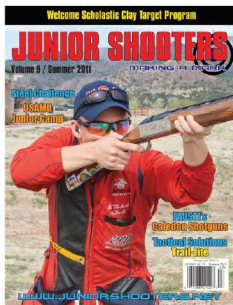

Caledon Shotguns

For Kids

For the junior-shooters out there and hope that I can continue to help promote shooting for the future. About six months ago I gave my pair of FAUST Caledon Over and Under (O/U) shotguns to try out a 12-gauge and a Youth Model 20-gauge. I have since shot both many times and have really enjoyed doing so. The standard 12-gauge model features a 34.17" length of automatically retracting magazine tube and a single detachable barrel. The highest quality Turkish walnut is meticulously shaped, oiled, and hand-painted to perfection. All models are offered in a 30" or 26" barrel. The 12-gauge model weighs 7.25 pounds, while the 20-gauge weighs a modest 6.5 pounds. The Caledon performs well on sporting clays courses and carries well in the field. Many classic and timeless qualities make the Caledon unique among others in the field. The Youth Caledon has a barrel length of 25" x 12.10" length of pull and weighs only 6.5 pounds.

harsh and very steep. The birds like it where they think they are safe from hunters, which is many miles away from easy access. I used the 12-gauge and absolutely loved it! It was great for the difficult terrain. When you hike all day long and use all your energy to get to where you want to be (which is on top of the bird), you want your gun to perform flawlessly. The FAUSTs passed with flying colors.

Ease of assembly: The two FAUSTs were a snap to put together and came apart easily. Both had a very tight action. A tight action is important if you want your gun to last a long time, which these guns will.

How it felt in my hands: The guns felt great in my hands, and I really enjoyed shooting them both. The 12-gauge fit me perfectly and shot right where I wanted it to. It was really smooth to shoot and easy to swing at a moving bird or target. The barrel was just long enough that you wouldn't miss something

that was short enough that it could be swung over your shoulder to get a last-moving object. The weight and overall feel of the gun was just what I needed to make it count. The 20-gauge was also fun to shoot. It was great for the bird made up for that disadvantage in other ways. It was lightweight and easy to shoot fast-moving birds because of this. I had a blast shooting both guns, and both felt great.

Sights: Each gun had a large brass bead at the end of its top barrel which was great. You could see birds and targets with great ease. The field of vision was enough that you could see where you were shooting and the target at the same time. I would not change the sight picture at all.

Recall: The recall was noticeable but manageable. Both light target loads and heavy game loads were fine to shoot through the gun, and with the interchangeable choke tubes, you could adjust the pattern of the gun if you wanted to.

Safety: The guns had a safety on the top of the receiver. It was a mechanical safety so you have to turn it off every time you close the gun. This is a great feature for bird hunting, which are what these guns are really made for, but not so much for shooting clay targets. The safety was easy to get to and turn off when it was time to shoot.

These guns were great, and I would not change anything on either of them. They were awesome in every aspect, and I had a blast trying them out!

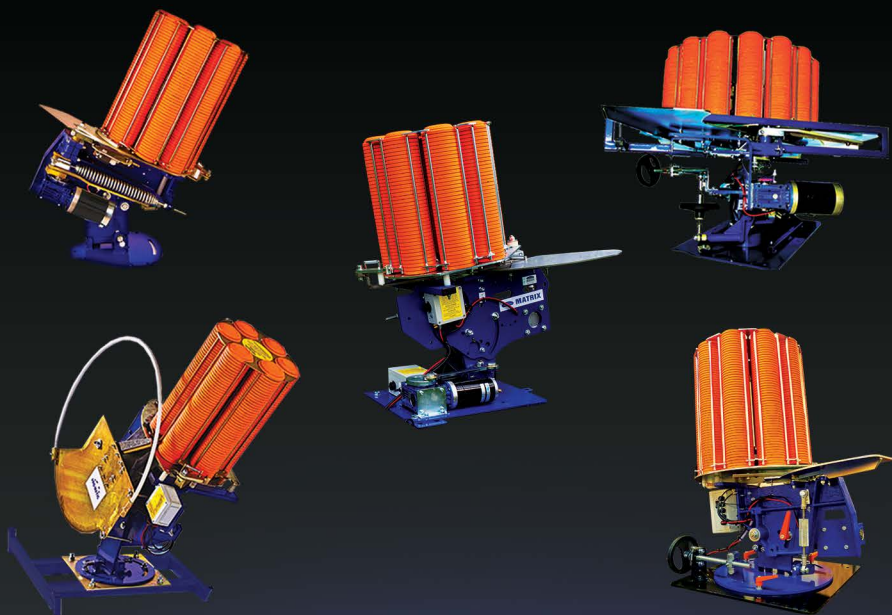
1. Current ATA, NSCA, NSSA, USA Shooting and SASP rules, as well as rules in this program and any match or National Director's bulletins posted on this range, govern this match.
2. All participating athletes and coaches must be registered and fully paid with the SSSF before competing. Event registrations are accepted on a first-come, first-served basis. For SCTP and SASP, all reservations will be done electronically through the team login at www.sssfonline.org.
3. All ammunition and practice rounds are the responsibility of the participant.
4. Alcohol/illegal or individually non-prescribed drugs and firearms do not mix. Alcohol and other illegal substances are strictly forbidden by the SSSF during this event. Further, any person who is found to be in possession of, or under the influence of, alcohol or drugs while using, cleaning, maintaining, inspecting, or otherwise handling their shotgun or any other firearm at any time will be immediately disqualified from the entire event and asked to leave without refund.
5. Safe gun handling and appropriate shooting attire are required. Flip-flops and open-toed shoes are prohibited. No tank tops, mid-drift tops or shorts above mid-thigh are allowed.

Reprimands will be issued based on violation and could ultimately mean disqualification from the tournament.

6. **Hat shooting is strictly prohibited during competition.** Once all competition has been completed, hat shooting may occur 1) ONLY after receiving permission from the tournament director or staff member and 2) under the supervision of a state advisor or coach. Any competitor who participates in hat shooting outside of both of these conditions will be immediately disqualified and asked to leave the competition without refund.
7. All shooters must sign the score sheet (next to the score total) before leaving the range.
8. Use of any tobacco product by anyone under the age of 18 is against Ohio State Law, and any use of tobacco product by an SCTP/SASP participant under the age of 18 is against SSSF guidelines. Participating in the use of tobacco products can be grounds for disqualification from the tournament.
9. Any athlete or adult disqualified from the tournament will not receive a refund of any tournament fees, game fees, practice fees or any other funds paid to SSSF or its agents.
